3. Read and approve the agenda

8. Discussion on Current Open Position and Hiring a Summer Temp

The Paving Foreman has decided to continue working for the Highway Department so there will be no need to fill this position at this time. The Commissioner also stated that for cost saving reasons there will only be the need to hire 1 summer temp instead of 2.

The Commissioner recommends to the Committee that these 3 employees be moved to permanent full-time status. 10. Review and Discuss Fund Balance Report

The Commissioner discussed that there is no plans for seal coating this year. The savings are to be put into the maintenance fund and eventually towards the County Y paving project. The Commissioner would like to get the Maintenance fund into the black for the start of 2020.

11. Discussion on Summer Work Schedule

The Commissioner shared with the Committee that the Highway Department has plans to complete the second hill, close up the site and permit, establish seed and mulch to finish up the work on County Y with plans to pave the road in 2020.

12. Commissioner's report.

- a. <u>State-</u> Currently washing bridges, shoulder maintenance, crack sealing on STH131. The State crew has plans of laying a lot of new asphalt down in 2019.
- b. <u>County-</u> Ditching and resetting culverts. A lot of cleanup from storm debris. County crews have been using the boom mower to clean up brush. The plan is to do a lot of section work this year.
- c. **Township-** Only emergency work as needed at this time.
