County crews have had graders out winging back drifts and problem areas. They continue to boom mow CTH E & KK as well as cut trees on CTH O & CTH H. Also keeping up with routine maintenance on all equipment and trucks.

Other Business

Ben Southwick sent a letter for the outstanding guardrail bill for Comar Ln with a Remit to for Payment as another attempt to reclaim funds owed to the Highway Department.

The Highway Commissioner got the Highway Department approved for a credit card at Tractor Supply.
